If you wish to adopt a child from abroad you are required to do so via an authorised Swedish adoption organisation. If the child is related to you or you have other special reasons to adopt without intermediation by an authorised adoption organisation, you must apply for permission from the Family Law and Parental Support Authority (MFoF). (Section 4 of the Swedish Intercountry Adoption Intermediation Act [1997:192])

Note

- The consent shall cease to apply unless the child is under the care of the applicant or applicants within three years after the consent was given.
- The applicant or applicants must notify the Social Welfare Committee of any relevant change of circumstance during the period to which the consent applies.
- Unless a child has been proposed for adoption within two years from the consent being given, the Social Welfare Committee shall, if deemed necessary, check whether there are any relevant change of circumstances.
- When the applicant or applicants have received notification that a specific child has been proposed for adoption, they are required to apply to the Social Welfare Committee to obtain the Committee's agreement to continue with the adoption proceedings.
